

**Town of Williamstown  
Annual Meeting  
Minutes  
April 18, 2017**

The Annual Meeting was called to order by Town Chairman Don Hilgendorf with six (6) town members and two (2) guests present.

Minutes from the previous Annual Meeting were read by the Clerk. Loris Geschke moved and motion was seconded by Allen Schellinger to accept the minutes from the April 19, 2016 meeting. Motion approved with five ayes and no nays.

The 2016 Financial Report was reviewed by the Clerk and citizen comments were taken. Allen Schellinger moved and Loris Geschke seconded the motion to accept the 2016 financial report. Motion approved with five ayes and no nays.

Old business: Dumpsters have been changed to accommodate increased recycling.

Under new business:

Mary Dessereau moved and Cindy Fredrick seconded the motion to give the Town Board the authority to repair and maintain roads and bridges at the Board's discretion up to \$500,000. Motion approved with five ayes and no nays.

Loris Geschke moved and motion was seconded by Cindy Fredrick to authorize the Town Board to spend up to \$500 on cemetery maintenance. Motion approved with five ayes and no nays.

Loris Geschke moved and motion was seconded by Allen Schellinger to appoint the Town Clerk, as a resident of the Town of Williamstown, to the Board of Review. Motion approved with five ayes and no nays.

Two (2) more residents joined the meeting.

Under other business:

The Town Officers discussed the regular monthly Board meetings being held the second Tuesday of the month at 6:30. No appreciable change in resident attendance and better timing for the Board.

One (1) more resident joined the meeting.

Rick Roll reported on the 2016 Kekoskee Fire Department statistics including 25 fire calls and 47 first responder calls.

Loris Geschke moved and motion was seconded by Allen Schellinger to adjourn. Motion approved with six ayes and no nays.
